

BllendDesignOffice has won awards for three interior design projects, displaying the company's versatility in creating different concepts.

'Conceptual Minimalism' was the target for the interiors of a relocating multidisciplinary design studio. Reflecting the studio's aesthetic and environmental concerns, the open plan space is emphasized by clean lines and huge glazed openings ensuring plenty of natural daylight. Different functions and routines are performed in the same section of a space which allows team members to interact and work together on a project.

'Redefinition of Mountain Typology' involved the major interior renovation of a three-level mountain house. The client's brief was to keep the mountain

context without using stereotypical, rustic elements. Chosen materials emit the architectural feeling of black burnt metal, pine wood and volcanic stone while a spiral staircase winds like a black ribbon from top floor to basement guest area.

'Neoclassic Wellness' is a project relating to the overall design and architectural corporate identity of a new cosmetology and spa company. It occupies the first floor of a neoclassic building and so needed to incorporate the advanced technological corporate profile in a building of historic importance. The application of lavaplaster on floors and walls, laminated formicas pressed on plywood, glass and quartz mosaics dominate the interior while the colour palette draws inspiration from the first light of dawn.
